

## MONTHLY IMBALANCE TOLERANCE PERCENTAGE CHANGE

For the June 2025 monthly imbalance trading period (which is from July 25, 2025 through July 31, 2025) and for the monthly imbalance trading periods moving forward, the positive and negative monthly imbalance tolerance percentages will be +10% and -8%, respectively (revised from +8% and -8%).

Monthly Imbalance Positive Tolerance: +10% Negative Tolerance: -8%

## **CYCLE 6 INTERRUPTIBLE NOMINATIONS ALLOWED**

Beginning Gas Day July 12, Cycle 6, Envoy users may enter interruptible End User -to- Storage nominations and interruptible Storage -to- End User nominations. (Note that Gas Day July 12, Cycle 6 will be confirmed on July 13 at 9:00 PM PCT).

## NO MAXIMUM CAPACITIES FOR THE STORAGE BALANCING FUNCTION

Beginning Gas Day August 1, 2024, SoCalGas placed values of 9,999,999 Dth in both the *Maximum Withdrawal Capacity for Load Balancing* and the *Maximum Injection Capacity for Load Balancing* fields to effectively remove the maximum capacities for balancing. Beginning Gas Day July 12, the aforementioned fields will be formally removed as Envoy's logic will no longer consider the maximum capacities for balancing in its equations.
